My Philosophy

It's "freerange" portraiture because it's natural, relaxed and unposed.

It's about beautiful, simple, stylish images that capture an emotion, images that will last a lifetime and not look dated in a few years.

That's why a shoot in your home and garden or place that's special to your family is ideal. It's your family's own environment where they're comfortable and can be themselves.

We keep it relaxed, fun and laid back and if I'm rolling around in the grass to get a smile then that's fine.



The Shoot.

A typical portrait shoot will take approximately one to two hours, but that is flexible.

It all depends on how children are feeling and how they're interacting with each other. I am patient when required but work quickly when the magical moments appear.

A change of clothes can be a good idea and I try to vary the location as well and if the weather isn't good we can reschedule.



The Viewing.

About a fortnight after the shoot your images will be edited ready to view.

I convert some to black and white and leave some in colour but they can be changed back as required.

The viewing typically takes about an hour and would generally be in your home. You can then order books, albums, frames or canvases. We can look at sample frames and I can even measure wall space and advise on picture groups.

I offer a bespoke framing service so if you want an image to fit an odd-shaped space on the landing we can do it.
