Colombia - Book 2 A few orchids and Insects

There were plenty of orchids seen but I only photographed a few (remembering the names is not easy). However we saw plenty of insects in Colombia and some of the most amazing appeared at night - the Dobson Fly and the stunning Dragon-headed Bug - along with some wonderful moths - see Book 3. There were plenty of bugs some days (especially around Jardin) and a few big beetles although not as many as I expected.

I wanted to see Monkey/ Airplane grasshoppers again (after seeing them in Ecuador) and there were many of them around, bright and colourful but almost impossible to ID, surprising given how nicely marked they are.

iNaturalist once again proved invalueable giving some IDs (often to genus only but I don't mind that). One or two relatively rare insects were photographed according to some of the comments which is always good.

Montezuma lodge was the outstanding insect site (although the Dobson Fly was seem at Minca).


